Between 2015 and 2018, David Lowe was a senior researcher with Google at the AI Group. From 2009 to 2015 he was co-founder and president of Cloudburst Research, a computer vision startup in Vancouver that was acquired by Google in May 2015. From 1987 to 2015, he was professor of computer science at the University of British Columbia.
